A MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Friends of Kawartha YFC / Youth Unlimited,

2019 was a significant year of growth for our Chapter in the areas of prayer, resources, and infrastructure, all of which have enabled us to reach more youth across the eight communities we serve. Year after year our purpose remains the same: to see every young person live fully in Christ. This is a big mission and we are grateful to God for partners like you and our dedicated team of staff and volunteers who are committed to reaching youth by **caring** for the whole person, **sharing** the life-changing message of Jesus, and **daring** them to follow Jesus.

This looks a little bit different in each of our communities, so I want to share with you some of the ways we have seen this happen over the past year:

CARE

A gift card campaign organized by our **Lakefield** Satellite, blessed over 30 families in need in the Lakefield area during the Christmas season. Our staff and volunteers have a connection with these families and youth through the programs offered in the community and school.

In **Lindsay**, our staff and volunteers are walking alongside youth dealing with significant social, emotional, and

educational challenges. Sometimes this looks like serving food at the school breakfast program, sometimes it's a conversation over coffee or lunch, and sometimes it's a ride to the bus station.

Every February, some of our staff and volunteers at The Switch Yard in **Bancroft**, host a Spa Night for women from the community. In this, we are able to care for them and love them through a night of pampering and fellowship.

The SHINE Girls Group in **Bobcaygeon** is for girls in grades 5-8 and teaches them that they are loved and valued by God.

SHARE

As a Chapter, we had the opportunity to share the life-changing message of Jesus with 920 youth in 2019. This is a growth of 34% from the previous year.

The Bridge Youth Centre in **Peterborough** reports that the majority of the youth who came to one of our weekly drop-in programs heard the gospel either in a one-on-one conversation or in a group format.

The partnership of our **Kawartha Lakes & Lindsay** Satellites had the opportunity to build relationships and share the gospel with youth on outdoor camping and canoe trips in Northern Ontario this past summer.

In **Haliburton** one of our staff began to build a relationship with a young Syrian refugee at the Skatepark. He has now been attending the local church youth group, asked God's forgiveness and is meeting with our staff for mentoring and to read through the Bible together.

DARE

In June we hosted the first week-long Jesus School (*a discipleship training school*) impacting 70 participants, staff, and volunteers from across the **Kawartha's**.

Our staff and volunteers were invited to teach at 4 local churches to equip and share tools on the topics of evangelism and discipleship.

In **Peterborough**, the Followers in *Training Program (FIT)* was launched to train and disciple youth to grow in their faith. This includes weekly meetings for Bible Study, work to complete at home and service trips both locally and eventually out of the country.

In **Bobcaygeon** the *Leaders In Training Program (LIT)* teaches youth what it takes to trust God and trust each other, and prepares them to be leaders in their own communities.

Infrastructure Changes

As mentioned above, 2019 was also a significant year for managing our Chapter's physical infrastructure. Some of the highlights in this area were:

Mortgage Paid Off: A partner challenged others with the offer of a matching donation, to pay off the mortgage on *The Bridge Youth Centre (256 Brock Street, Peterborough)* by 2020. The mortgage was paid off in February 2019!

Purchase of New Building: A partner provided us with an interest free loan to purchase 25 Bridge Street in Lakefield! This will allow us to expand our youth outreach and partner with other community ministries and organizations.

New Satellite Vision: Staff changes in our Kawartha Lakes Satellite were announced as well as a new vision and roles to reach Fenelon Falls and the greater community, including the five surrounding elementary schools.

I want to thank-you for your investment in *Kawartha YFC / Youth Unlimited*. We reached just under 2800 youth in 2019, in 40 different locations, through 48 church partnerships and 26 church denominations. This was accomplished through the prayer, hard work and dedication of 241 regular and seasonal volunteers and 24 full and part-time staff. We are looking forward to 2020 and all that God has in store for this mission as we continue to work together to reach youth for Christ across the Kawarthas!

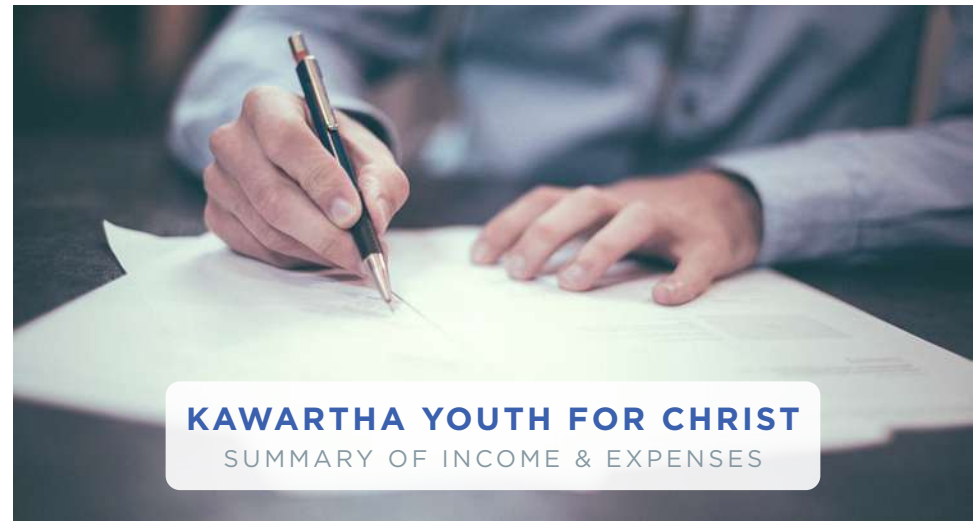

MESSAGE FROM THE SATELLITE DIRECTOR:

2019 was an exciting year for us, as it marked our **20th anniversary at The Bridge Youth Centre** in downtown Peterborough. It was also the year that we were able to pay off our mortgage! We want to say a BIG thank you to all of you for your prayers and partnership over the past 20 years. We have BIG dreams for where the Lord will take us in the years to come!

Peterborough Youth Unlimited is a hub of ministry that is impacting youth and their families in our city. It is a safe space where youth know that they can come and that they will be loved unconditionally. This year, we focused on “deepening our impact” with the youth we serve.

Another key focus of our year was developing discipleship pathways for youth as we invite them into a deeper relationship with Jesus.

2019 saw the growth of the Peterborough Youth Network, where we hosted 3 youth rallies and invited young people from across different youth groups and churches to be praying in unity for their highschoo

We also completed our first year of the *FIT (Followers in Training)* program, intentionally journeying with a small group of youth. Our FIT Youth engaged in service learning projects locally, in Toronto, at a camp in northern Ontario and at a First Nations reserve in northern Quebec.

LAKEFIELD



Lakefield Youth Unlimited (LYU) is the new owner of a 4,400 sq. ft. building prominently situated off the Lakefield Village bridge. This added space provides our satellite with so much more potential for reaching the youth and their families in our community. This new building will provide prospective space for life skill programs, after-school events, elementary and Jr. High programming, a shared meeting room, open gathering spaces and new expanded offices. An anonymous lender provided a no-interest, no-payment loan to purchase the building, and many individual donors are helping us raise funds for an additional \$75,000 to pay for renovations.

To date, even in our unfinished building, we have been able to host a temporary scooter park for Jr. High youth, run events for students unable to attend school during teacher strike days and provide space for the Lakefield Festival of Trees. We look forward to sharing in 2021 more specific ways in which God has directed us to use our new facility as a means of reaching youth for Christ!

MESSAGE FROM THE SATELLITE DIRECTOR:

Kawartha Lakes Youth Unlimited is a satellite comprised of two communities: Bobcaygeon and Fenelon Falls. These communities work together as one satellite in order to impact the youth in Kawartha Lakes. We have had the pleasure of serving in Kawartha Lakes for the past 15 years.

We work to provide a community in which youth are mentored and supported to find wholeness in Christ and reach their full life potential. We offer fun and engaging programs as well as resources that support the mental, physical, and spiritual health of the youth in our communities to show that they are deeply loved and valued.

Throughout 2019 the afterschool programs we offered were On-Target Archery, Karate, Shine Girls Group, Re-Create Art Program and Come Cook With Us. In the summer, we ran a Leaders In Training Camp, Specialty Camps for art, cooking and sports as well as 4-day camping trips.

LINDSAY

Lindsay Youth Unlimited has been present in the community of Lindsay for 9 years. It is our mission to see everyone young person living fully in Christ and we aim to do that by building relationships with the youth in Lindsay. So, how do we get to a place where we can tell a child or youth their worth in the eyes of God? We must first have a relationship with that young person, they need to trust us and we need to be proved trustworthy. The way we can display that trust is through time committed, dedication to be present and consistent, shared experiences, the conversations we have and the genuine care that we show for the lives of the young people we work with. Through any *Youth Unlimited* program, no matter the modality, there is one thread that connects them all and that is that the *Youth Unlimited* staff is there for the best interest of the youth. That shines through in any activity. Whether teaching archery or how to hammer a nail, the time and care put into that relationship is what builds the trust. The trust is what opens the door for the conversation about faith.

Here are some different ways you can volunteer with us:

STEERING TEAM MEMBER: The purpose of a Steering Team is to provide vision, support, encouragement and prayer for the community and our staff serving in that community.

PROGRAM VOLUNTEERS: We typically ask for program volunteers to be involved in one youth program for the duration of one school year or one full week of summer camp.

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT: The volunteer assistant role is to support program staff in making the programs we offer more awesome.

VOLUNTEER DRIVERS: Help us by driving kids to and from events or camp experiences. You must be 25, have a G driver's license and \$2 million liability insurance on your vehicle.

MEAL & SNACK SUPPORT VOLUNTEERS: Bake and drop off baked goods for programs or come in during a program to prepare snack/dinner for the youth.

EVENT VOLUNTEERS: The ideal event volunteer is someone who wants to get involved with *Youth Unlimited*, but can't commit to a regular program.

GUEST SPEAKER: We would love for you to visit a program and share about your profession and how you live out your faith!

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: *Youth Unlimited* does our best to stay connected to the various events that are happening in our community and churches, as well as making sure we are up to date on all our communities have to offer! If you are connected to a church, agency or business that we have a partnership with or could benefit from being connected to, we would love to chat about having you in a liaison role keep us connected.
