Over the winter, she used her skills and passion for skating to lead a group of young women in a "learn to skate" program.

Mary feels fulfilled walking alongside the youth at YFC as they discover their own potential. She is grateful to be a part of YFC and to build relationships with London youth.





"When I began working at YFC, my coworkers and I visited Glen Cairn communities to spend time with the local youth and learn about the needs **of** the community, **from** the community. While visiting one neighbourhood—a local subsidized housing division, filled with children—I witnessed the wide gap that exists between the resources provided to children on opposite ends of our city.

A mother shared with me that the city had demolished this community's only playground and stated that they planned to build a new one. This was several years ago. The playground hasn't been rebuilt, and all that is left is an empty grass lot and a broken concrete sidewalk. To stay entertained, the kids find whatever is available to play with including mounds of trash.

We spent time with these children and were amazed by their openness to accept us into their backyard. When we returned two weeks after this first visit, they came running towards us with open arms. The ease with which they accepted us into their community, as friends rather than guests, demonstrates that a simple act of kinship leaves an imprint on each of us."
