

Work Force Job Studio Coordinator Full-time Permanent

Under the guidance and support of the Work Force Director, the Job Studio Coordinator sees to the development, implementation and expansion of our youth employment preparation and training ministry consisting of two parts. Serving Winnipeg's at-risk population ages 16 to 20, the first part of this ministry aims to teach and develop work related skills and opportunities that effectively prepare our students for employment. Following the regional school schedule, the Job Studio starts recruitment in September, runs classes from October to April, with a class graduation in April. The Second part aims at developing internship and employment opportunities for the youth upon graduation. The overall aim of the position is to intentionally build a safe and nurturing community, to specifically teach employment skills while providing opportunity to encounter Jesus Christ. The position also includes recruiting, leading and mentoring a team of volunteers, as well as developing community contacts. Although currently a north end community outreach the goal is to develop its potential and expand to reach at-risk youth in other areas of the city.

The ideal candidate will need experience working with and compassion for Winnipeg's at-risk youth population; demonstrate integrity, initiative, a strong work ethic and organizational skills; be passionate about the mission of youth evangelism and discipleship; have excellent interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills; be a team player with strong relational and people skills to inspire, motivate and equip others; demonstrated leadership experience working with program staff and volunteers; and have a valid MB class 5 drivers' license and access to a vehicle.

All staff of Youth For Christ Winnipeg must be active participant of an evangelical church and community, have a Christ honouring testimony, and be in agreement with YFC's Statement of Faith and Community Commitments.
