Chanice was in Grade 7, attending William Whyte School in the heart of Winnipeg's north-end when she first heard about YFC's Work Force program, which runs out of the church across the street from the school. She was very shy, and usually kept mostly to herself, but she had heard she could get practical and paid work experience in the program, so she mustered up the courage to get involved with the program.

"I was amazed at how the leaders managed to connect with each kid in the program," said Chanice. "There were so many kids, but somehow they managed to spend quality time with each of us. That meant a lot. I think that's why kids keep coming. That's why I kept coming back. I really felt wanted and valued."

The Work Force program at YFC connects youth to an

array of various work placements and experiences in the community. Youth learn how to work, problem solve, and get along with others in order to get a job done! A small honorarium is provided by Work Force for their efforts and valuable service to the community.

When not in their job placements, the youth engage in relationship building activities, games and teaching times. Each participating youth is paired with a specific mentor to connect, listen and even go for a treat from time to time! At Work Force youth are told they have talents and abilities that can lead to meaningful lives. They are taught, challenged, and encouraged to dream what life would be like with Jesus in their lives.

"At first I was intimidated by the one-on-one times

with my mentor, because I was so shy," said Chanice.

"But eventually I got better at it, and it was during those times when we were really able to talk about God, and that's when my friendship with Jesus became real." Chanice started her friendship with Jesus as a result of her being a part of Work Force, so when she decided she wanted to get baptized she asked if she could do it at Work Force! "It was important to me that both my families be there. My mom and sister were there, and my Work Force family was there."

"It's been such a blessing to watch Chanice bloom and blossom," beamed Shaunna Goode, former Work Force coordinator and current YFC Community Minister for the William Whyte neighbourhood. "To witness that, and to actually be the person to baptize her, and then

to see her now volunteer in the program…I can only describe it as a "proud mama" moment!"

Chanice now regularly volunteers with the younger kids at Work Force, sharing what she's learned in her relationship with Jesus, and nurtures and encourages other youth, and is currently raising support to come on staff at YFC!

"Jesus is my best friend," said Chanice. "People come and go, but He's the one friend that won't leave you. I just want to express that to other people...to let them know that Jesus can be their best friend as well."
