AN UPDATE FROM YOUTH FOR CHRIST WINNIPEG

Thank You! Your partnership makes the difference

We want to take this opportunity to say an enormous Thank You for your partnership with us in the ministry work of YFC Winnipeg over the last year! Because of you - because you have chosen to partner with us and responded to God's prompting - we have been able to continue the work God has called us to, offering an opportunity for every youth to be living fully in Christ. This is the heart of what we do and who we are.

Because you have partnered with us through prayers and financial support we have been able to keep working in these challenging times, adapting as best we can with each unique restriction. Our staff have been able to creatively find ways to stay connected with youth and offer as much programming as we are able.

With your help, we were able to engage in the lives of thousands of youth this last year. We are able to offer ten ministry programs out of our Winnipeg center making available Dance, Climbing, Ball Hockey, Soccer, Skateboarding, Drop-In, fitness challenges for physical health resourcing, resources and support for young parents, job skills training, as well as counselling and mental health resources.

Because of you we were able to have youth ministers present in three Winnipeg neighborhoods (South Osborne, Kildonan & William Whyte), partnering with local churches. We are able to offer programming and support in seven surrounding communities connecting with youth in Arborg, Gimli, Selkirk, Stonewall, Carman, Niverville, and St. Pierre. We were able to minister at our Cedarwood Camp location on Pinawa Bay near Lac du Bonnet serving youth and offering space in nature to retreat.

Your help has enabled us to have hundreds of volunteers (including 90 new volunteers) serving youth this last year. We've been able to provide more than 35 staff with ASIST suicide intervention training, and over 60 people with SafeTALK skills, equipping them to be a support for youth who may be thinking about suicide.

Your partnership allows us to continue offering hope to a world that feels tired and worn down.

We are shining light into dark places and offering healing to brokenness. We are able to offer a third way that only Jesus can bring in a polarising time. Because of you partnering with us, youth are able to discover that they can live an abundant life in Christ.

Thank you so much for choosing to be a part of this ministry work. We couldn't do it without you.
