MINISTRY FEATURE: WORK FORCE HOPE IN THE INNER CITY

ZOEY'S STORY: Zoey has a dream of becoming a musician and song writer but struggles with getting all her school work completed. She has been part of our homework club, where youth like Zoey can get some extra support with their reading, writing, or math work homework that can be frustrating and difficult to get done at school or at home. Zoey also says that she struggles with fitting in, but not at Work Force. "When I feel like I have no one to be with or talk to, I go to YFC Work Force program nights (like Wall Crashers and Infinity) and I feel like I'm not alone," she says.

REECE'S STORY: She stared coming to YFC for the interaction, which she doesn't get from school. Reece has been part of Infinity and Job Studio and says, "It's been great to be involved in something fun and interesting, and being around other people, especially after the recent pandemic lockdowns." One thing that stands out about the Infinity group that Reece regularly attends is the relationships she is able to have with the leaders. "Their openness and caring attitude makes God seem real and something that I want to be a part of, and I never really got that from anywhere else", says Reece. She is becoming more aware of God's love for her, that He will love her no matter what she does, and has started taking important steps to have a relationship with Jesus, through praying and asking lots of questions or her leaders.

VIOLET'S STORY: Violet has been a part of Work Force for three years now, and notes that it is a safe place where she can be herself. She has made so many friendships and credits the leaders for helping her with a lot. Currently she is getting help finding a job, and continues to develop an understanding of God's love for her.

The core of our Work Force program is mentorship, pairing caring adults with youth so that authentic and meaningful connections can be made. We believe our youth have talents and abilities that can lead to meaningful lives, and we strive to lift them up by supporting their personal development and challenging them to dream what life would be like with Jesus in it.

GIVING PROJECT: LANDSCAPE FOR CHANGE



Youth for Christ is centrally located at Higgins and Main Street, and many youths in this area live in poverty or are at risk of homelessness and ultimately become targets for gangs, prostitution, and the drug trade. They are tempted by perpetrators with the promise of a better lifestyle and offered a way out by participating in one or more of these unhealthy activities. Many get trapped in this cycle of poverty and addiction. These youth need the hope Jesus offers!

The goal of this campaign is to open the area in front of the YFC building up with a beautification project that will enhance the area and make it more appealing to the community at large. The project will expand much-needed parking space for staff and volunteers and create a much safer environment outside for youth using the facility. The space will include better lighting and visibility and will include easier access to YFC off Higgins Avenue with a drop-off loop for parents and/or buses.

It is our hope that these improvements will encourage more youth and families to explore our facility and access the programming being offered, getting them involved in healthy activities and away from the temptation of street life.


We are looking forward to the construction phase getting underway. We are hopeful this project will be completed by late 2022.

GIVING PROJECT: YFC CARMAN EXPANSION

YFC Carman, a satellite location of YFC Winnipeg has been a strong presence in the community for over 30 years. Serving 170 young people over the past year programming runs every weeknight and includes a variety of groups and activities,

The Back Door Youth Centre (YFC Carman's Drop-In facility) has acquired the neighboring property and is currently in the process of raising additional capital to make their expansion plans a reality. In an effort to increase program capacity and service opportunities, the plan involves adding roughly 4,000 square feet to the current drop in centre, included in the addition is a gymnasium and a commercial-sized kitchen.

The opportunities provided by this expansion will be a huge blessing to the many young people that YFC Carman serves, allowing all programs to run under one roof. Construction is expected to start in late 2022.
