Our ministry in Arborg has been experiencing some exciting momentum over the past year. Since last summer our regular attendance has grown from 5 regulars to roughly 25. From one staff member and 2 volunteers to 10 caring adults involved. Every week, there seems to be 1 or 2 new youth because a friend has brought them. Financially, the community has also donated more than double what was given last year! We feel the community's strong support and give praise to God that has caused this ministry to flourish!

We have a deal where the youth

can earn 10 cents of canteen credit for every Bible verse that they read out loud to a Staff or Volunteer. On any given night several young people will say, "I'd like to read 10 verses for a pop". On average, about \$75 of canteen credit gets given out at every boy's drop-in night! We strongly believe that there is power in the spoken scriptures within the lives of the youth we have the opportunity to connect with. Through this initiative, we've had so many meaningful spiritual conversations with the youth, and have given them invitations to receive Jesus into their lives.
