Manage Satellite Leadership - includes staff support, performance management, staff/volunteer training, recruitment, volunteer development, co-leading team meetings, overseeing spiritual development, budgeting, purchasing, marketing communications (web, social media, newsletters), deputation management, and working with LYU Satellite Director to envision and plan for future direction and programing

<u>Fundraising and Partner Development</u> - has the ability to secure and maintain a sound base of financial & prayer partners to a level sufficient to fund the salary and immediate costs of this position; includes monitoring and oversight of staff as they do the same
