We are deeply thankful for her perseverance, creativity, heart for Jesus, and love for others—especially during a critical season of rebuilding after COVID—including highlights like the summer Art Drop-In, partnership with the Selwyn Library Makerspace, and her support of students in local schools, which strengthened relationships that will continue to serve LYU well.



Gym Nights at LDPS

We're excited to welcome Hailey Jones as our new Gym Night Coordinator, bringing years of experience and a passion for youth to our Thursday Gym Nights at Lakefield District Public School, where 40+ students in grades 6–9 gather weekly for sports, crafts, and character education grounded in a Biblical perspective. Additionally, our Student Leader Program provides students in grades 9 and 10 with the opportunity to serve as junior leaders, assist with setup and cleanup while developing valuable life and relational skills.



Choir

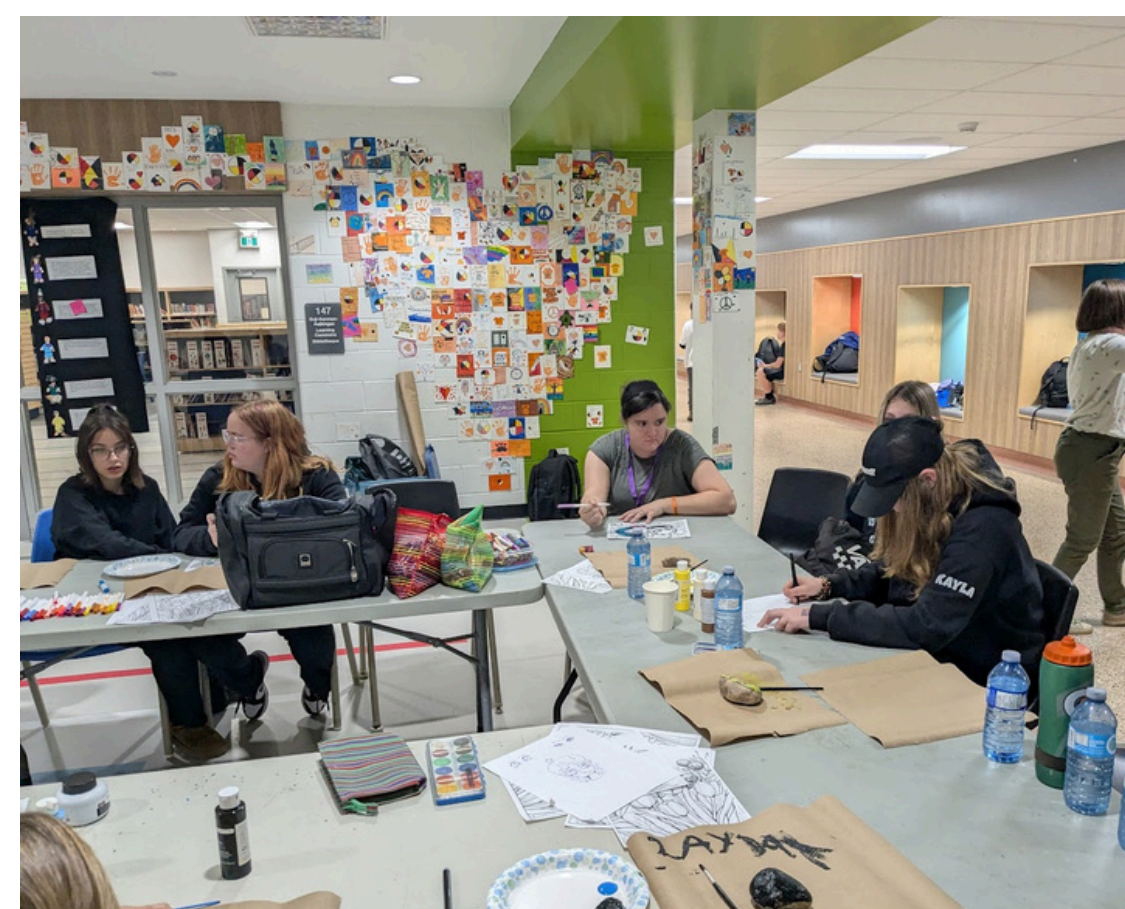

Carpentry Program

This fall, we were excited to launch our new Carpentry Program for students in grades 9-12, led by dedicated volunteer Ephraim Wolters and Gabrielle Blanshard. Each week, students worked hands-on to create kalimbas, taking projects from raw materials to finished pieces. Beyond learning how to measure, cut, and assemble, the program created a positive space where youth could grow, problem-solve, and take pride in what they accomplished together. This coming winter, LYU will be tasking this group to create and install bench seating and a serving counter to serve snacks for programming in our basement.
