


# You will want to be in the room on November 3rd and here is why!

Thus began months of planning!! During the week of July 21-25, that is what it became. Five days of games, kitchen skills, bible discussions, delicious food, and so much fun occurred...even more than we expected. Thirty-five campers between the ages of 10-14 attended. Everyone really enjoyed themselves and the time spent with each other. Our volunteers were fantastic and we loved hearing the curiosity about God and the bible that developed in the campers over the course of the week. The volunteer leaders led discussions after a little Bible talk every afternoon, and by the end of the week campers were asking deep questions and wanting to find out more for themselves about what the Bible says. What more could we ask for?!
