Olivia likes to read comics, unfortunately, these comics have inappropriate messaging for youth her age. It has come up a lot as we clean up breakfast club together. I want her to keep on reading, but I want her to choose wisely so I try to introduce her to other genres.

As we were cleaning up one day, I was commenting on how we were not perfect and are all works in progress. She became real quiet at this, as she does when she's thinking seriously and deeply, and then she said, "If I become a Christian, would I have to give up my comics?" We are not alone in the room at this time so I was cautious, but not hesitant to tell the truth. I said to her, "Yes, you'll have give up certain things when you give your life to God. But that's between you and Him, and He'll work with you in His timing." She thought about this and then said, "I don't think I'll ever give them up." "Isn't it interesting that I am sitting here talking with you?" he said.



Then, last week, he told me that their community wants to work with us and one of the reasons is that their youth were excited about being together with the Esquimalt youth. They do have concerns about the "religious element" of our ministry and want to "negotiate" on some of the content.
