




CAMPUS LIFE-CLAUDIO ARCNICIBA

Many agencies came around her with plans to house her and baby, plans to help her with finishing school and plans to help her with programs geared to young mothers and I got to jump in and help fill any gaps. Michelle and I met as often as she needed and talked through everything and anything.

I am happy to report that Michelle has a bright beautiful happy and healthy little 2-and-a-half-year-old. She has graduated from the Young Parent program with the Boys and Girls club and has moved into an apartment on her own. She is on track to graduate from high school later this fall and has plans to attend hairdressing school after. Thanks to a community effort this young mom and daughter have a bright future ahead.

They are also teaching many teen moms who are is desperate situations how to sew, using supplies we sent, giving them an opportunity to earn a living and find hope for their future.

More than 75% of the 109 they work with in the program decided to follow Jesus. What a priviledge to support what God is doing abroad!
