Seen, Known, and Loved

"Jesus looked at him and loved him"

Mark 10:21a

Lately, I have been moved by a little detail in the gospel of Mark. All of the gospels tell the story of a rich young man who came to Jesus, asking what he must do to inherit eternal life (which in Jewish understanding was a question about how to have a joy-filled, deep and meaningful life with God). He was a man of deep dedication, which had given him much earthly success. But his question showed that even with all his achievements, he was still looking for something more. He had anxieties or doubts around his worthiness, asking "what must I still do?'

In each gospel we are told that Jesus responds, "Go, sell all that you have, give to the poor and follow me." We then read of the man's distress and hesitation.

However, there is a sentence, found only in Mark's account, which is perhaps the most pivotal point of the whole encounter. Mark tells us, Jesus looked at him and loved him (Mark 10:21). A moment of compassion, tenderness, and deep love. A powerful look.

Instead of responding to the man by offering him only a task to complete, or another achievement box to check, Jesus paused and looked deeper into the man's unvoiced insecurity or anxiety, and he offered him love and an invitation to be with him and follow him.

This response may have been

difficult to digest. Sometimes this invitation, to be known and loved by God, is a challenging step to take. It might involve vulnerability, or undoing some of the things we have built our lives upon. But for those of us that have experienced new life in Christ, we know the identity of being His beloved, receiving His love, and being known by Him is more than worth it.

Here at YFC Winnipeg, this experience is what we long to offer to the youth we work with. We believe this starts with offering loving, embodied relationships to the youth we serve. Through fun activities, meals, mentoring, and support, we want our youth to know they are seen, cared for, and loved by our staff and volunteers, but more importantly by Jesus. As with the story of the rich young ruler, each youth has the option to choose how they might respond. The choice of letting yourself be loved sometimes comes with a cost, but we know it brings a reward beyond our comprehension.

Please join us in praying that our youth will respond to these invitations of being seen, known, and loved.

Because of your support towards our Summer Staff Subsidy Fund we were able to hire 32 people to our summer team. They have helped plan and lead in a variety of ways, and supported our summer programs allowing us to share the love of Jesus with hundreds of youth this summer, many coming to YFC program for the first time!

God's Love Story: Film & Media

It's been amazing to see how many great opportunities there are available during the summer months for the Film & Media Ministry. Between day camps, one-on-ones, and the special events that youth help film and capture, there have been many moments to mentor youth and help them live fully in Christ.

One such highlight was the first day-camp this summer. Over the course of three days together we made a film and learned how we can be a part of God's story. "It was incredible how spending long days together brought up some deep and honest questions from the youth about faith.

Seeing the youth working together to overcome the various challenges that come with writing, filming, and editing a film in just 3 days, was such a great experience, and we got to see them grow in many ways.

One particular youth came to the camp despite not knowing any of the other youth. It was his first time to YFC. Throughout the week we observed him go from being unsure of himself to a youth who felt confident and encouraged. We could definitely see how the positive environment and spirit of Christ-like love that exists here had a big effect on him. He was given the responsibility to direct the whole film that we had created together and had a blast doing it.

And he was not the only one to

feel this. All who had attended the Film & Media Ministry left with the message that they themselves are a part of God's story, and had been filled with self-confidence and courage. We give the glory to God, the one who has created us, who knows our stories and loves us no matter what, and who empowers and emboldens us all to use our gifts for His glory.

We are excited to keep sharing Jesus's love story and see youth further impacted by the Gospel as we start into regular ministry programming again this fall.

Because of your support of the Film & Media ministry we are able to offer a fun, welcoming environment for them to explore their creative side, build confidence in themselves. and ultimately discover how they are part of a much bigger story, God's story.

Revealing God's Love: Masterworks

This summer, Masterworks has been able to put on two weeks of summer camp! For ages 8-12, we have offered a week of Dance Camp, and a week of Arts Camp in August. When considering the current climate that these young people are growing up in, we decided to focus on helping youth in discovering their purpose this summer by asking and answering the question: Who does God say I am?

Today's youth are bombarded with confused ideas of identity; whether it be through the chaos of social media, equally confused peers, or the general societal decline of absolute truth. They are often left with many questions and no one to point them to the truth and life to the fullest.

journey of pointing youth to Jesus to discover that they are created with a purpose that is unchanging and unmovable. Discussion revolved around concrete truths such as: God made me in His image, He has given me a unique purpose and special gifts to fulfill that purpose, I can creatively express God's love, I am meant to think about beautiful and praiseworthy things, I can know the wise thing to do, and most importantly - I am a beloved child of God whose true identity is found in Christ.

Our theme verse for the summer was Psalm 139:14,"l praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well".

Between dancing, doing crafts, and having our God Talk times,



youth began to ask big questions and tell parts of their stories to our teachers and summer staff. At 9 years old, one of our dancers began to ask questions about death and a beautiful moment was shared as we had the opportunity to explain that Jesus defeated death so that we do not have to fear it.

This was just one of many conversations where we were able to witness God revealing

His love for our youth, and we are so excited and blessed to have the opportunity to keep this momentum going throughout the school year!

Shekhina, one of the volunteers from the YFC Arborg Drop In, shares that one highlight from this summer was an opportunity she had to have a heart to heart conversation with one of the girls. This youth shared of her personal struggles with depression & hurt experienced from discussing the bible in the past.

Shekhina was able to explain that just because we go through tough stuff, that doesn't mean that God isn't with us. She goes on to encourage this young person to make sure they are spending time with Him, praying and being in His word every day, so that she would be filled up spiritually. Ensuring that what she feels and projects outwardly is good and pleasing rather than the intrusive

thoughts, doubt and hurt of past events. They then read through Psalm 40 together.
